Cost of Entry

- ABA entry is \$350 per team (max 6 people). Includes ABA fee, power & camping
- ▣ SCA entry is \$150 per person participating in the steak cook-off as well as the ancillaries. Includes SCA fee, power & camping. If you choose to do just the steak, the fees are still \$150 per person. If you choose to do the ancillaries without entering the steak cook-off it will be \$25 per ancillary category.
- ▣ Must be pre-paid and pre-booked before close of nominations on 11/02/2021
- ▣ Refunds are not available after the close of nominations unless due to COVID
- ▣ Teams to bring their own powerboards, extension cords, tents & lighting
- ▣ ABA Site size approximately 6x6 metres per team on grass.
- ▣ Bigger sites available on request. Camper Vans and Motor Homes are welcome
- ▣ SCA only site size is 3x3 metres
- ▣ Only competitors & their families are allowed on site overnight. All accommodation must be within your allocated site
- ▣ Showers and designated toilets just for the teams

Categories

- Chicken – Any cut
- ▣ Pork ribs
- ▣ Lamb – Any cut
- ▣ Pork 1 – Any cut
- ▣ Brisket

Cash Prizes & Trophies

SCA

Steak: 1st \$1000, 2nd \$500, 3rd \$250, 4th \$125, 5th \$75

Tacos, Burger, Wings (for each category): 1st \$125, 2nd \$75, 3rd \$50

The winner of every SCA-sanctioned event will get a Golden Ticket to the SCA World Championships. And there will be a Golden ticket for the winner of each ancillary category as well.

ABA

- Grand Champion - \$1,500 Cash
- Reserve Grand Champion - \$800 cash
- 1st place in each category \$500 cash
- 2nd place in each category \$300 cash
- 3rd place in each category \$200 cash

Total prize pool in excess of \$10,000/-

Prizes will be paid out via bank transfer within a maximum of 7 days on receiving bank details via email from the team captain.

Promoter's Rules

Teams must have safety vests and closed toe shoes on during bump in/out.

All associated electrical equipment must have a current test tag.

Any marquees must be weighted down appropriately.

Team sponsor advertising is allowed provided not deemed excessive by the event co-ordinator. All banners to be within your allocated space, not including the fence. No signs above 2.4m.

During opening hours the event is a licenced venue. No outside alcohol is allowed during these hours. Please don't serve any alcohol to the general public as we will have a number of bars that they can purchase from. Being a licensed event no glass is allowed onsite on the days of the public event including bottles or drinking glasses.

Supplying members of the public with your food is against the local councils laws. Only the judges may sample the food.

The ABA Head Judge decision is final in the event of any dispute.

There will be a number of COVID safety measures which you will be updated on before the event but the main things will be to have as much 1.5m physical distancing as possible, increased sanitisation, absolutely no sampling allowed (even for vendors), everyone's contact details recorded and most importantly anyone who is feeling unwell has to stay away from the event please. All team members will need to sign the COVID declaration on arrival.

Please note that teams are not permitted to sell any products (including but not limited to rubs, sauces, jerky, meat or any BBQ related products like thermometers, knives, charcoal, wood, cutting boards, fire-pits, smokers, etc...) at the event without paying a vendor fee as we have vendors that pay to do this. You are more than welcome to sell merchandise in the form of your team's branded Tshirts, hoodies, aprons, stubby coolers and hats.

NOTE: Poor food safety practices may result in the SCA or ABA Head Judges excluding the team from competing, excluding a particular meat or food from being handed in or warnings given as required and at the sole discretion of the SCA or ABA Head Judges.
